A Summary of the May 14, 2019 Palestine ISD Board of Trustees Called Meeting

Meeting called to order at 12:02 PM.

Pledges of allegiance to the American and Texas flags were recited.

Bread/Milk Vendors

David Atkeisson, Chief Financial Officer stated that the district had received bids for bread and milk products from only one vendor for each product, and that the bids received were from the same vendors that the district had used the previous school year.

The Board awarded bread and milk contracts for the 2019-2020 school year to the following vendors:

Cafeteria Upgrades

David Atkeisson, Chief Financial Officer; presented information to the board regarding the need for upgrades to the Palestine Junior High School cafeteria/kitchen and an HVAC adjustment in the PHS cafeteria. Mr. Atkeisson explained that there were funds earmarked for cafeteria upgrades in fund balance and that district had been made aware by the Texas Department of Agriculture that the funds exceeded the recommended amount. Therefore, funds were available for the upgrades. The Board approved the recommended cafeteria upgrades.

Election Canvass

The Board of Trustees compared the May 4, 2019 Election precinct returns with the corresponding tally lists.

Candidate for Place 3 was Jeffrey Kyle Schwab (Unopposed Incumbent) who received 439 total votes.

Candidate for Place 4 was Kurt Herrington (Unopposed Incumbent) who received 446 total votes.

Candidates for Place 5 were Davi Killion Ingram (Incumbent) who received 470 total votes, and Tanya Jordan who received 157 total votes.

The poll lists from early voting and Election day reflect a total of 635 who voted in the PISD Board of Trustees Election on May 4, 2019.

The Board adopted a resolution certifying the results of the Palestine Independent School District, May 4, 2019 Election results.
