A Summary of the July 6, 2021 Palestine ISD Board of Trustees Called Meeting

Call to Order

Vice President, Jeffrey Schwab called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM, announced that a quorum was present, that the meeting had been duly called, and that notice of the meeting had been posted for the time and in the manner required by law.

Invocation & Pledges

Trustee Dyna Tutt gave the invocation and pledges to American and Texas flags were recited.

Public Comment

There were no requests for public comment.

Discuss impact of ESSER III on 2021-2022 School Calendar

Superintendent Jason Marshall reminded the Board that at a previous school board meeting he had informed of a possible need to add several staff development dates to the 2021-2022 school calendar to allow time for staff training on new software purchased with ESSER III funds. Superintendent Marshall informed that the calendar already contained staff development dates each month and that it no longer appeared that there would be a need to add more than one day or a half-day for staff development to the calendar. Superintendent Marshall stated that the item would be placed on a future agenda for further discussion and possible action.

Welding Simulator Purchase

Brian Howie, Director of College and Career Readiness and David Atkeisson, Chief Financial Officer shared information regarding a new allotment; College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Outcomes Bonus allocation in the Foundation School Program from HB3 of the 86th Legislature. Mr. Atkeisson informed that this fiscal year, the district was required to spend a little over \$100,000 on CCMR Outcomes Bonus-related expenditures. Mr. Howie informed that use of the funds had to be directly related to industry based certifications and shared that he recommended the purchase of 4 welding simulators to allow students to practice welding skills prior to actually welding, and that two of the welding simulators would be mobile so they could be taken to other campuses to provide younger students the opportunity the experience of simulated welding. The Board approved the purchase of four (4) welding simulators from CCMR Outcomes Bonus Funds.
